Acting

Adult Improv

Tuesdays 7:00 – 8:00 \$64

Learn the art of improvisation (and have a lot of fun). Do you need a night to let off some steam? Has your boss told you that you need to improve your ability to think on your feet? In this session you'll learn the basics of improv, taking risks and working as a team. We need a minimum of 6 students for this class to run. Once we have six we will offer the class on a weekly basis for \$10/session. Come when you can!

Ages 2 – 3 Saturdays 9:30 – 10:15

Bring art to life. Students will use famous paintings by artists like Seurat, Picasso, and Monet as the basis for imaginative play. Each day we will study a painting and bring it to life with storytelling, pantomime, music, movement and our own art projects. Adults come along for the fun with your 2 – 3 year olds.

Creative Drama Ages 3 – 5

Mondays 1:30 – 2:15 \$48

Each session is a new adventure for students as we have fun with dramatic play, story enactment, imagination journeys, theatre games, music, and movement. "Let's pretend" is the norm for our creative drama class, not just a child's game. Through their experiences with drama, students develop their imaginations and their confidence.

Destination Imagination Ages 6 – 8

Mondays 4:30 – 5:30 \$64

Each day is a new adventure as students take a trip of a lifetime. Go anywhere in the world, and to any point in time. We'll use the power of your imagination to take an amazing journey, developing your vocal, physical, and ensemble skills along the way. The last day of class will showcase student's work.

Make a Scene Ages 9 – 15

Mondays 5:45 – 6:45 \$64

This fun format introduces students to warm-ups, stage direction, theatre etiquette, character analysis, scene work and more while learning ensemble building skills and gaining self confidence. Students will work as an ensemble to perform a scene from a play.

Young Playwrights Ages 9 – 15

Tuesdays 5:45 – 6:45 \$64



Students will learn all the techniques necessary to write for the stage including dialogue, character, story arc, stage direction as well as basic writing skills like brainstorming, writing from the heart, and trusting your instincts. The goal: To write an original short one act play with interesting characters, dramatic pull, and a satisfying conclusion.

Wiggle Worms **Ages 2 – 3**

Mondays 10:45 – 11:30 **\$48**

An adventure in rhythm and sounds combining songs, dance, stories, musical instruments and art for a whole body experience. This course is designed to introduce creative techniques in implementing music and movement in to kid's lives. Adults come along for the fun.

Broadway Beat **\$64**

Have you always wanted to dance on Broadway?! Learn basic jazz technique and musical theater vocal technique so you can sing and dance to your favorite Broadway tunes! Students will learn songs and choreography to popular Broadway musicals.

Juggling **Ages 9 – 15**
